On the day of admission, you must bring: Child's original birth certificate, original Social Security card, insurance card, and photo ID

Clothing

9 pairs of pants and 9 shirts (jeans, shorts, or sweatpants).

- Included in the 9 outfits there must be **2 sets of gym clothes**.
- Undergarments and pajamas; bra, underwear, socks. (No thongs)
- Jacket/hoodie, belt
- Leggings must be worn with longer shirts.
- Shorts must be no shorter than **1 inch above the knee**.
- Tank tops must have straps at least **3 fingers wide** (no spaghetti straps).
- Clothing may not show the midriff or cleavage, or excessive skin
- **2 pairs of shoes** (one must be tennis shoes) plus shower shoes or flip flops

Toiletries: one month supply

Toothbrush and tube of toothpaste

Shampoo/conditioner (no pumps)

Deodorants (roll-on or stick only)

Body wash and lotion. (No perfumed lotions, alcohol-infused products or bar soap)

Hairbrush, comb, or hair pick

Females: One-month supply of feminine hygiene products (tampons, sanitary napkins, etc.)

Medical & Financial

List of prescription medications or a physician's statement listing:

Name of medication and dosage

Reason for medication

Minimum of \$20.00 for replacement toiletries(optional)

School & Communication

School books, school-issued computers, and classwork

Stamps, envelopes, and stationery for mailing letters

DO NOT BRING

1. Dresses or skirts
2. Clothing displaying alcohol, tobacco, or drug-related images
3. Weapons of any kind, including but not limited to guns, knives, chains, razors, sticks, scissors
4. Tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, pipes, chewing tobacco, snuff, dip)
5. Lighters or matches
6. Pencils, pens, markers, highlighters, paint, glue, 3 ring binders, spiral notebooks
7. Condoms
8. Products containing alcohol, including but not limited to: Hairspray, cologne/perfume, mouthwash
9. Fingernail files, tweezers, clippers, eyebrow trimmers or shapers, fake acrylic fingernails
10. Food, gum, candy, or drinks
11. Glass products
12. Stuffed animals or blankets
13. Electronics of any kind (radios, TVs, video games, cameras, cell phones)
14. Makeup or jewelry of any kind (you may wear plastic retainers for piercings)
